

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

- Listen to others with increasing attention and respond appropriately.
- Understand and use 'how' and 'why' questions.
- Retell events in the correct order.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Take responsibility for small tasks e.g. putting on shoes and doing up their coats.
- Accept the needs of others and take turns and share resources, sometimes with support from others.
- Recognise that behaviour needs to adapt in different social settings, events and changes to routine.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Use one-handed tools and equipment such as scissors.
- Hold a pencil between their thumb and forefinger, no longer using whole hand grasp.
- Copying letters including the letters of their name.

SEESAW

- We are posting photos and videos of the children onto Seesaw on a weekly basis and love your comments!
- Thank you to all who have added 'Wow Moments' to your child's Seesaw journal. We have shared many of them with the children already and they love sharing their achievements. UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

- Learning about some of the things that make them unique.
- Talking about some of the similarities and differences in relation to friends and family.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

- Using role-play and small world play to develop narratives.
- Use a range of materials to create 'art'.

LITERACY

- Daily phonics sessions.
- Phase 2 learning the single letter sounds (phonemes) and what they look like (graphemes), and how to blend and segment.
- (Please refer to our Phonics guidance for further explanation.)
- Weekly guided reading sessions in a small group (the book will be sent home the following week)

MATHEMATICS

- Focusing on the numbers 1-10. Concepts such as place value, number bonds and counting on and back from a given number.
- Concepts of shapes; both 2d and 3d.

ROUTINES

- Library books and levelled guided reading books are given out on Mondays and new ones given out the same day.
- Phonics home learning is sent on via Seesaw on Fridays.
- Fruit and water is required every day.
- PE is on Wednesdays. Please ensure your child has trainers on these days. A PE kit in school is useful in case of any accidents. Please label every item of clothing.
